Out of 12 students two secured above 90 % marks in Commerce Stream and 75% of students scored distinctions. Adhithya M G with 97.4% was the school topper in SSCE Result. Gayathri V secured 94% and became the second topper of the school and Aparna G Nath took the third position with 85.8 %.
